FREQUENTLY ASKED ?



Q WHAT DOES A NORMAL DAY AT CAMP GRACE LOOK LIKE?

You can expect your child to experience activities like swimming in pool and lake, archery, canoeing, fishing, nature walks, rock climbing, riding horses and much more!



Q WHO WILL BE SUPERVISING MY CHILD?

Every child is placed in a cabin group with no more than seven to a group. Each group is lead all week by one of our trained college age summer counselors. There is an extensive interview and background process as well as a 10-day training every counselor is a part of. Your child will always be supervised well in the care of Camp Grace staff.



Q MY CHILD IS NOT A STRONG SWIMMER. IS THIS AN ISSUE?

Safety is the highest priority at Camp Grace. When swimming in the Activity Lake everyone is required to wear a size appropriate life jacket. All swim areas are supervised by Red Cross certified lifeguards.



Q WHAT DOES CAMP GRACE DO ABOUT MEDICATIONS OR MEDICAL EMERGENCIES?

Camp Grace has a Registered Nurse on site. We will collect all prescription and over the counter medicine and our nurse will organize, dispense and document all medications.



Q MY CHILD HAS MEDICAL OR RELIGIOUS FOOD RESTRICTIONS. CAN CAMP GRACE ACCOMMODATE THIS?

We are aware of the increase in food allergies and other restrictions to diet. Our food service staff is able to accommodate most any specialty food need. Though we do like to state clearly that there is a difference in having a food restriction and simply not liking certain foods.



Q WILL I BE ABLE TO CONTACT AND TALK TO MY CHILD WHILE THEY ARE AT CAMP GRACE?

We encourage all communication to go through the partner leader that is accompanying your child to Camp Grace. Those leaders are encouraged to take photos and give updates of your child. We have learned over the years though that unless it is a family emergency it is best not to make contact.
